Belfor Environmental Services, Inc., an emergency response/asbestos abatement contractor was hired to perform the emergency cleanup of asbestos contamination created during maintenance activities at the Foothills Water Treatment Plant. The clean up involved two very large and critical portions of the treatment plant (filter galley #2 and the main influent channels of the plant). The cleanup was very labor intensive and lasted for approximately 8 weeks.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Cleanup was completed in April 2009, The invoice was received in June once the contractor received all of the required backup on cost from subcontractors utilized for the cleanup. Approve ratification of payment.
