As previously addressed, Denver Water has worked over the last year to develop a library of standards for use on our projects. These standards include the *Capital Projects Construction Standards*, *CAD Standards*, and *Engineering Standards*. Denver Water continues to work on the release of both the *CAD Standards* and the *14<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Engineering Standards* in order to improve internal efficiencies as well as coordination with our distributors, consultants, and contractors.

The *14<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Engineering Standards* and the *CAD Standards* will be released for use in January 2012. Synchronizing the release of these two standards will allow for a more seamless approach to working with Denver Water. The *CAD Standards* will include user guides to specific project types on the 2011 AutoCAD platform. The *Engineering Standards* continue to build on our rich history while keeping up with revising codes and industry standards. The next edition of the *Capital Projects Construction Standards* will not be released until January 2013.
