Second Amendment with Discovery Garden Inc. for Digital Repository and Records Preservation Services Contract 503618

Purpose and Background:

The purpose of this board item is to increase funds on contract 503618 with Discovery Garden Inc. for continued professional support for the Drupal application. The Records and Documents Administration (RDA) team uses Drupal to build and maintain the current data repository, where most of Denver Water's digital, official records are stored. The software allows RDA to manage and showcase Denver Water content while ensuring the data is preserved for the future. RDA has been satisfied with the support Discovery Garden provides and is asking for additional funds to ensure continued delivery of services until the contract expires on July 30, 2023. Staff has started negotiating terms and pricing for a contract renewal at that time.

Budget and Schedule:

The amount requested for this Second Amendment is \$14,695.83, bringing the total contract amount to \$308,195.83. The term of this contract is July 31, 2018, to July 30, 2023. Funds for this contract will come from the approved budget for IT Enterprise Resource Planning, which has sufficient funds to pay the \$14,695.83 needed in 2023.

Selection of Business Partner:

In May 2018, the services for Digital Repository for Access and Preservation of Permanent Digital Records were competitively bid through an issued Request for Proposals via Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing System (BidNet), Denver Water's Public website. The original contract with Discovery Garden Inc. has one existing Amendment for \$3,500 to the original contract which brought the Not To Exceed amount to a total of \$293,500. This is the second amendment to this contract.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Board approve the Third Amendment to Contract 503618 with Discovery Garden Inc., for digital repository and records preservation for the contract term July 31, 2018, to July 30, 2023, and for an addition of \$14,695.83 for a total amended contract amount not to exceed \$308,195.83.

Second Amendment with Synertech Inc. for Information Technology Batch Operation Services Contract 504249

Purpose and Background:

The purpose of this board item is to increase funds on the Synertech contract 504249 to continue monitoring very large IT batch operations. Many Denver Water processes are automated and scheduled to run at night and on weekends to avoid congesting Denver Water's network and interrupting day-today operations. Synertech monitors all these off-hours batch operations in case of failure and ensures processes are corrected quickly.

Budget and Schedule:

The amount requested for this Second Amendment is \$349,000, bringing the total contract amount to \$829,552. This proposed amendment will also extend the contract with Synertech Inc. through March 31, 2025. Funds for this contract will come from the 2023 approved budget for IT Customer Information Systems, which has sufficient funds to pay the \$174,500 to be needed in 2023. The remaining \$174,500 will be budgeted in 2024.

Selection of Business Partner:

In January 2020, the services were competitively bid through an issued Request for Proposals via Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing System (BidNet), Denver Water's Public website. The original contract with Synertech Inc. was for a three-year term. There has been one Amendment for \$6,000 to the original contract which brought the Not to Exceed amount to a total of \$480,552. This is the second amendment to this contract.

S/MWBE Information:

Small/Minority and Women-owned Business Enterprise goals are not applicable for this item.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Board approve the Second Amendment to Contract 504249 with Synertech Inc. for Denver Water's Information Technology batch operation services for an extension of the contract period through March 31, 2025, and for an addition of \$349,000 for a total amended contract amount not to exceed \$829,552.
