RE: Engineering Standards, 15th Edition

Denver Water's Standards Library includes the *Capital Projects Construction Standards (CPCS)*, *Engineering Standards*, and *Computer Aided Drafting (CAD) Standards*. These standards collectively allow Denver Water to manage both capital and distribution construction projects. Projects prepared by or submitted to Denver Water are subject to the *CPCS*, the *Engineering Standards* when dealing with distribution pipe and service lines, and the *CAD Standards*.

Denver Water's publication of the *Engineering Standards, 15th Edition* is effective June 30, 2018 for use on all projects designed and constructed within Denver Water's contract area. The *4th Edition CAD Standards Procedures Manual* is scheduled for release on July 23rd, 2018. After the respective release dates of each respective document, please download the most current version of the *Engineering Standards* and the most current version of the *CAD Standards Procedures Manual*.
